FRIENDS OF SAINT DOMINIC'S HOME GOLF TOURNEY RAISE \$325,000

When it comes to golf there is no doubt that Ronald J. Sylvestri, John T. White Jr., David T. Meberg, and Hector A. May are game. But when the golf is for Saint Dominic's Home, they tee up a long drive of generosity and more.

The four gentlemen are responsible for the success of the 17th Annual Friends of Saint Dominic's Golf Tourney, which took place in August at the Edgewood Country Club in River Vale, N.J. Nearly 200 golfers representing area businesses, many in the building and construction trades in New York City, chipped in to raise more than \$325,000 for the nonprofit agency. Under Executive Director Judy Kydon, the programs of Saint Dominic's Home include foster boarding homes, adoption, special needs education and community-based services and residences for people with mental illness or developmental disabilities. Headquartered in Blauvelt, N.Y., Saint Dominic's serves 2,000 people and families in the Bronx, and Rockland, Westchester and Rockland counties.
